All of the classes have been having tennis lessons each Thursday with Premier Sports and the children are really doing well and developing their skills.

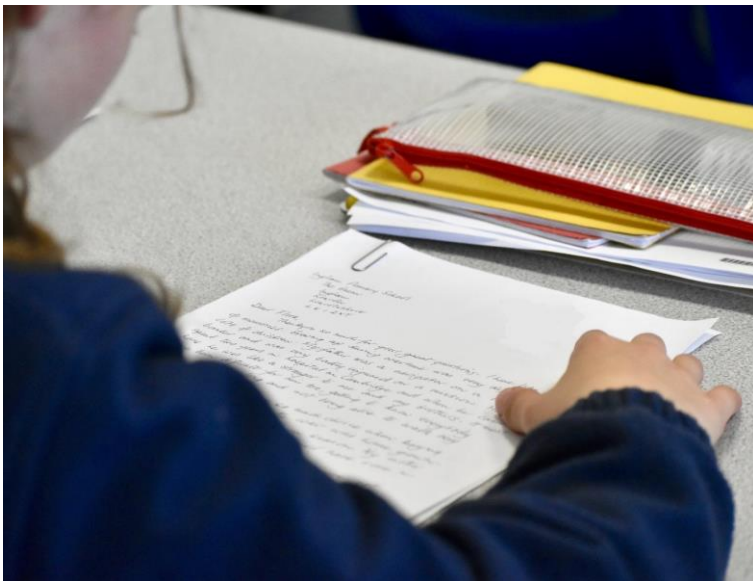
