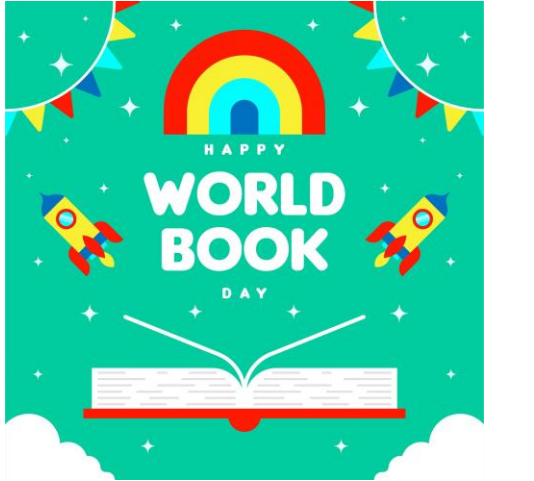
11+ Registration
