Online Safety workshops

Rowan, Maple and Oak classes all took part in Online Safety workshops led by the Stay Safe Partnership.

Rowan class had great fun learning about staying safe online. They talked about who can help them if something goes wrong or something happens that they don't understand. The children then drew around their hands and filled it with drawings and the names of adults in their lives that could help them.

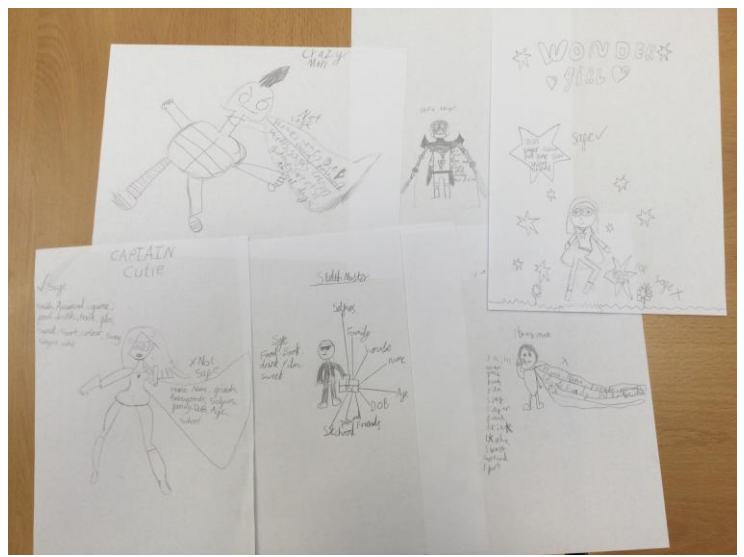
Maple Class had great fun using the theme of 'Superheroes' to learn about how to protect their identity while online. They revised which bits of personal information should stay private and which bits are OK to share. Everyone then designed their own superhero with a cape, box or case to list all of the things they should not share with anyone online.

Oak Class learnt about how difficult it is to distinguish between AI and real life, and so care must be taken to not believe everything they see. They also discussed how screen time can impact their mood.



Fire Safety Session

All children in Rowan Class (Year 1 and 2) and Oak Class (Year 5 and 6) took part in a Fire Safety session run by Lincolnshire Fire and Rescue. This was informative and the children in both classes asked lots of questions! The children's enthusiasm and interest was praised by the facilitator which was brilliant to hear.



Knife Crime Session

This session was delivered to our children in Y5/6 by Lincolnshire Police. Again, the children had lots of questions and they behaved impeccably.

Please do speak to your children about the different workshops they took part in as it is essential we teach the children about being safe both online and in the real world.

Maple and Rowan's Class Trips

Linking with their learning about the Romans, Maple Class enjoyed a trip to Posterngate, hidden under the ground in Lincoln. They learnt about how Lincoln was a busy trading place and that Posterngate means 'small gate'. They also went on a walking tour of the Roman remains in uphill Lincoln, tracing the route of the city walls and four main gates into Lindum Colonia.



Rowan Class had a fantastic trip to Lincoln Castle and enjoyed a very busy and exciting day. The children were brilliant throughout and represented the school wonderfully. They learnt about the different parts of the castle and the roles people had in the past, made their own shields, and even had a go at archery. It was a memorable experience for everyone!
